



Prevention of COVID-19 – Important Notes for Exhibitors and Trade Visitors/Guests from Mainland China Regarding Epidemic Prevention

I. Anti-Epidemic Requirements for Exhibitors from Mainland China

- Before entering the exhibition hall, exhibitors must present their exhibitor badges and Macao Health Codes, wear masks, and take body temperature checks.
- While in the exhibition hall, exhibitors should wear a mask properly at all times and observe a distance of at least one metre from others.
- Exhibitors should prepare disposable gloves, alcohol-based hand sanitizers, extra masks, and so on.
- Exhibitors should keep their booths well-ventilated, wear a mask properly while talking to traders, have proper seating plans, and practise social distancing during negotiation.

Important Notes for Entering Macao

- Exhibitors entering Macao from Mainland China must present a valid negative nucleic acid test report/sampling certificate issued from Mainland China/Macao within the last 7 days, a green Macao Health Code, and a valid travel document.
- Exhibitors from Mainland China can convert their Yuekang Codes to Macao Health Codes by clicking the “Convert Yuekang Code to Macao Health Code” button on the webpage. The page will then automatically jump to the designated Macao Health Code website. After filling in and submitting their health history, contact history and travel history, exhibitors will receive their Macao Health Code.



- While entering Macao, exhibitors need to present the Macao Health Code to the Health Bureau staff of Macao.
- Proof of a negative COVID-19 test conducted within the last 7 days must be presented:
 - Upon boarding a Macao-bound vessel/aircraft;
 - Upon entry into Macao; or
 - Upon entry into a casino in Macao.

II. Anti-Epidemic Requirements for **Trade Visitors/Guests from Mainland China**

- Visitors must wear masks, present Macao Health Codes, and have body temperature checks before entering the exhibition hall.
- Visitors should wear a mask properly at all times and observe a distance of at least one metre from others.
- Keeping distance and avoiding shaking hands are recommended.

Important Notes for Entering Macao

- Visitors entering Macao from Mainland China must present a valid negative nucleic acid test report/sampling certificate issued from Mainland China/Macao within the last 7 days, a green Macao Health Code, and a valid travel document.



- Trade visitors from Mainland China can convert their Yuekang Codes to Macao Health Codes by clicking the “Convert Yuekang Code to Macao Health Code” button on the webpage. The page will then automatically jump to the designated Macao Health Code website. After filling in and submitting their health history, contact history and travel history, trade visitors will receive their Macao Health Code.
- While entering Macao, trade visitors need to present the Macao Health Code to the Health Bureau staff of Macao.
- Proof of a negative COVID-19 test conducted within the last 7 days must be presented:
 - Upon boarding a Macao-bound vessel/aircraft;
 - Upon entry into Macao; or
 - Upon entry into a casino in Macao.

Converting Yuekang Code to Macao Health Code

Step 1



- Click the “Convert Yuekang Code to Macao Health Code” button.
- Click the “Submit Personal Information” button and confirm submission.

Step2



- The page will automatically jump to the designated Macao Health Code website.
- Fill in your health history, contact history, and travel history, and click the submission button.

Step3



- On the basis of epidemic prevention rules, the system will show your Macao Health Code in green, yellow, or red, accordingly.
- Present your Macao Health Code to the Health Bureau staff of Macao while entering Macao.



Important Notes:

- To ensure a negative result of nucleic acid test has been obtained prior to arrival in Macao, all inbound travellers should present a valid negative nucleic acid test report issued by a recognised Macao or Mainland testing institution pursuant to the requirement of the Macao SAR Government or the Health Bureau.
- Validity of negative reports: Within 7 days after the sampling date for individuals entering Macao from regions other than Hong Kong (for example, if the sample was taken on 10 August, the validity period shall be up to 17 August).
- If necessary, travellers may obtain new nucleic acid test reports from the following qualified COVID-19 testing organisations announced by the health authorities in Macao:
 - Health Bureau
 - Kuok Kim (Macao) Hygiene Testing Co. Ltd.
 - Kiang Wu Hospital
 - University Hospital
